

Our Program

The Preschool staff is licensed by the State of Hawaii Department of Human Services and meets all of its requirements for a student body of (68) sixty-eight. The children are divided up accordingly to their age group. The 3 and 4-year-olds share one large classroom while the 2-year-olds have a classroom of their own.

Our weekly curriculum is based upon themes that incorporate activities and lessons of basic educational tools for higher learning.

In addition we have a very safe and enclosed playground for the children to run and play in, trike area for riding tricycles, and a built in sand-box for children to sit and play in.

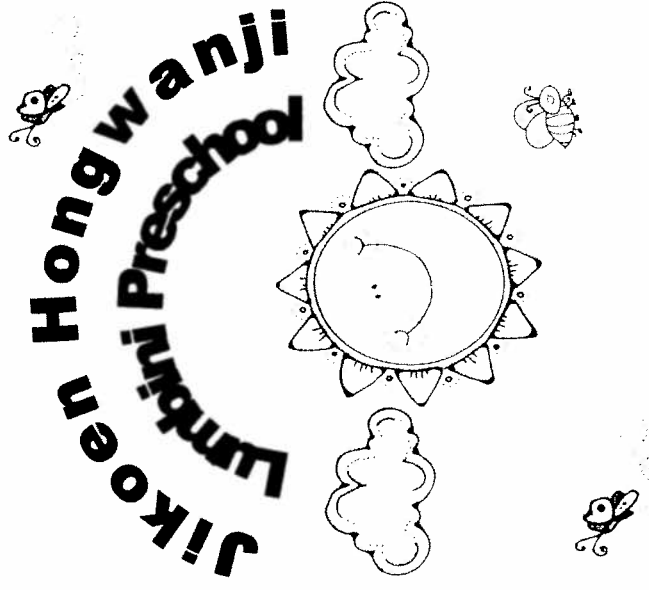
Our Curriculum & "Learning Centers"

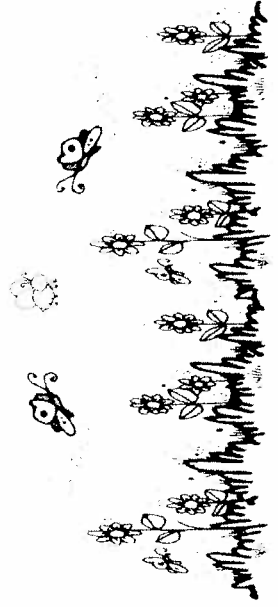

School Operation Schedule

We are open year round from 6:45 a.m.-5:30 p.m. Monday - Friday. The school is close on all state and federal holidays; the last 6 days in July, School closes at 11:30 a.m. on the last day before winter vacation, 2 weeks Winter Vacation, 1 week in March for Spring Vacation and 1 days Temple Holiday during the month of April and May. We accept enrollment year round based on availability. Our regular school year starts in August and ends in May. June and July is our summer program and is a total of 8 weeks.

Admissions Requirements

- ☞ Child must be 2 years old
- ☞ Children 2 years old in pull-ups
- ☞ Children 3-4 years old must be toilet trained.
- ☞ Child’s health record (Form 14) or updated immunization health card.
- ☞ Updated physical exam and tuberculin skin test
- ☞ Copy of birth certificate
